



DOTP: AN IMPORTANT START

SIBUR launched the production of DOTP, an eco-friendly plasticiser for the construction industry.

In late May, SIBUR's Perm site cut the ribbon on the new dioctyl terephthalate plasticiser (DOTP) facility. The event was attended by Dmitry Kozak, Deputy Prime Minister, Maxim Reshetnikov, Perm Territory Governor, Dmitry Konov, Chairman of the Management Board at SIBUR Holding, Viktor Evtukhov, Deputy Minister of Industry and Trade, and Pavel Sorokin, Deputy Minister of Energy, as well as local authorities and SIBUR's clients and partners. After the launch ceremony at SIBUR-Khimprom, Dmitry Kozak hosted a meeting on development of the petrochemical industry.
